LSO comments: The application for an extension of licensed hours is beyond the normal terminal hours of 1am set out in the Shetland Islands Area Licensing Board Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 Statement Of Licensing Policy 2018 – 2021. However, the policy allows extension of hours application to be considered by the board where they considers it appropriate in connection with a special event or occasion to be catered for on the premises or a special event of local or national significance.

This application is a first time occasional licence application where they exceed hours so must come before the Board for determination.
