2 <sup>nd</sup> June	Coronation Day, Union Flag
10 <sup>th</sup> June	Birthday of the Duke of Edinburgh, Union Flag
21 <sup>st</sup> June	Shetland Flag Day, Shetland Flag
3 <sup>rd</sup> September	Merchant Navy Day, Red Ensign Flag
September*	Battle of Britain Week, R.A.F.A. Flag
24 <sup>th</sup> October	United Nations Day, UN Flag
November*	Remembrance Day, Union Flag
14 <sup>th</sup> November	Birthday of the Prince of Wales, Union Flag
30 <sup>th</sup> November	St. Andrews Day, Scottish Saltire Flag
