Days on which flags may be flown on local government and public buildings

Recommendations of Lord-Lieutenant

From 8am until sunset:-

6 th February	Her Majesty's Accession, Union Flag
21 st April	Birthday of HM the Queen, Union Flag
25 th April	Anzac Day, New Zealand and Australian Flags at Entrance
9 th May	Europe Day, European Flag
17 th May	Norwegian Independence Day, Norway Flag
2 nd June	Coronation Day, Union Flag
10 th June	Birthday of the Duke of Edinburgh, Union Flag
21 st June	Shetland Flag Day, Shetland Flag
25 th June	Armed Forces Day, Special Union Flag with Logo
3 rd September	Merchant Navy Day, Red Ensign Flag
- September*	Battle of Britain Week, R.A.F.A. Flag
24 th October	United Nations Day, UN Flag
- November*	Remembrance Day, Union Flag
14 th November	Birthday of the Prince of Wales, Union Flag
30 th November	St. Andrews Day, Scottish Saltire Flag

*The dates for Battle of Britain Week and Remembrance Day change each year. Members of each association provide information on dates prior to each event.

On dates, which the full SIC is meeting in the Town Hall, the Shetland Flag is to be flown throughout its duration.

On days when former SIC Members' funerals are being held the SIC Flag is to be flown for the duration of the service.

Requests from individual organisations flying their own flags on special occasions, i.e. 50 or 100 year anniversaries, will be considered by the Convener.
