OBJECTIONS

Any objections or representations in relation to the application should be made to Shetland Islands Council, Environmental Health, Gutters' Hut, 7 North Ness, Lerwick, Shetland, ZE1 0LZ. Within 21 days of the above-mentioned date.

Any objections or representations must:

- be in writing,
- specify the ground of the objection or the nature of the representation,
- specify the name and address of the person making it,
- be signed by him or on his behalf.
- Was made to them within 21 days of whichever is the later or, as the case may be, latest of the following dates:
 - (a) Where the public notice was given in a newspaper, the date when it was first so given;
 - (b) Where Shetland Islands Council have required the applicant to display the Notice again from a specified date, that date;
 - (c) In any other case, the date when the application was made to them.

Such an objection or representation shall be considered to have been made within the period referred to if it is delivered by hand within that period or posted (by registered or recorded delivery post) so that in the normal course of post it might be expected to be delivered within that period.

It should also be noted that where an objection or representation is made to the Council after the date referred to but before a final decision is taken on the application, it is competent for the Council to entertain it if satisfied that there is sufficient reason why the objection or representation was not made within the period of time stated.
