Passing Place Sign at Uyea Junction

Response from Roads Dept. highlighted that, as the Highway Code guidance is not to park in passing places, there is no prescribed sign to instruct drivers not to park. Since it is not listed in the "Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions" then strictly speaking its provision on the public road would be illegal. "Therefore, only in circumstances where vehicles are parked in hazardous locations would we consider bending the rules regarding the permitted signage". Members agreed that there was therefore little more that they could do. **Action: Remove from next minute**
