Delivering learning about Participation Requests is a planned action in <u>Shetland's Community</u> <u>Learning and Development Plan 2018-21</u>. Training was arranged for Community Learning & Development staff and community participation bodies around Participation Requests, which was delivered in May 2020 by the Scottish Community Development Company.

Transforming Participation is a project included in the Shetland Partnership's Delivery Plan 2019-22. It aims to build on existing good practice and improve the quality and effectiveness of community engagement and participation. 'The participation of and with communities lies at the heart of community planning' and engagement should be shaped around the needs of the seldom heard. Closely linked to Shetland's Community Learning and Development (CLD) Plan, this project is about learning from what has worked well; sharing good practice, information and guidance through an online hub; and harnessing the knowledge, talents and capacity within partner organisations and the community to create and embed new ways of working.
