Barrier above Hillend

An issue was raised by both a CCIIr. and a CIIr. about a join in a barrier at the above location which had been altered to install "drop-ends" instead of the previous type. This was on a corner which was already a hazard with tourists stopping to take photographs and it was felt that this would encourage more to, not only stop there but to step over the join at a point with a considerable drop. It was advised that these "drop-ends" were being installed in several locations due to a recent RTA which resulted in a post coming through the windscreen of the vehicle. The CCIIr. who raised the issue stated that he had spoken with the Roads dept. who said that the join could be removed if the landowner had no objections. CCIIr. had checked with landowner and he did not object. It was therefore agreed to contact SIC to officially request this.
