Works will involve shotblasting and painting with the use of workboats and floating platforms. Passing vessels are instructed to maintain a safe distance and minimal wash when passing the work site.

Works will be carried on the pier structure as the diagram below. The landside area in red will be cordoned off for works equipment and plant.




Fig 2 – Toft Pier showing restriction on ferry lay-by Berth
